
Home Reading

Children should be reading at home daily.

Their reading record will come home every day and should be brought back to school every day.

Any reading they do should be recorded in here.

They will be checked in school at least once a week on a Monday.






Children will have a Little Wandle Phonics or Fluency book at their level to bring home. It is important that this is kept in good condition and returned to school every day.

The Fluency books progress from Fluency 1 to Fluency 10. Fluency 1 books are designed for a reading speed of 60wpm up to Fluency 10 for a reading speed of 120wpm.

Home Tables Practice


The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) is a key stage 2 statutory assessment to be taken by pupils in June of year 4.





In class we are following the Number Sense Tables Fluency programme where we learn 36 tables facts.

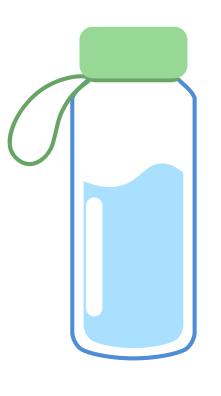

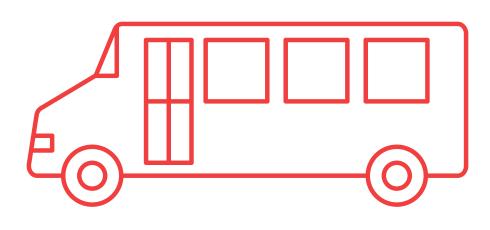
